Scarification

Key Benefit

Gives the grass plants the opportunity to thicken, which in turn aids air and water flow and helps withstand moss invasion.

What is it:

This is a mechanical procedure for the removal of decaying material on the soils surface; this in turn opens channels for water, air and nutrients to get through to the soil giving the grass plants the opportunity to grow through and dominate the area again.

The thatch is collected, bagged and removed from the lawn.

Aeration

Key Benefit


Improves drainage and promote healthy grass by relieving compaction.

What is it:

An effective way to improve the drainage and ensure oxygen supply to the turf roots which will enable healthy root growth. This procedure is vital to control of moss..

Hollow-Tine aeration helps to reduce thatch and sub surface soil compaction, which is normally found on clay soils. During the process a core of soil is removed from the lawn.

The cores are collected, bagged and removed from the lawn.


